## EXTENSION NOTICE OF SCHOLARSHIP : 2021-22 (Pre-Matric Scholarship for Minorities)

The Ministry of Minority Affairs (MoMA) provides an opportunity to the students belonging to six Minority communities notified by the Government of India (Jain, Buddhist, Sikh, Zoroastrian (Parsis), Muslim and Christian) for availing scholarships under Pre-Matric Scholarship for the year 2021-22. "Assam Minorities Development Board invites online applications for above scholarship, given by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India for the above scheme".

### Timeline

Last date for submission of applications for Fresh scholarship (first time applicant) and Renewal scholarship (applicant who has got scholarship during 2020-21) by students is extended up to:  
**(Pre-Matric Scholarship)**

December,  
2021

### Eligibility

The applicant should be the student of the notified minority communities (Jain, Buddhist, Sikh, Zoroastrian (Parsis), Muslim and Christian).

The applicant/student should be pursuing studies in India in **Government/ Provincialised/ Recognised/ Recognised Private School/Institute.**

Pre-Matric Scholarship will be awarded to the students of Class I to X who have secured not less than 50% marks in the previous final examination. The eligibility criteria of 50% marks for both Fresh and Renewal students under Pre-Matric scholarship for the year 2021-22 has been relaxed by the Ministry. A student passing the previous final examination/ promoted to next class will be treated as eligible for renewal scholarship and can apply as fresh scholarship under Pre-Matric scholarship for the year 2021-22. Family annual income of their parents/guardians from all sources should not exceed Rs. 1.00 lakh. Scholarship will not be given to more than two students from a family.

### Instructions

#### **For Applicants/ Students:**

Applicants are advised to apply online against the scholarship scheme on the website of National Scholarship Portal at **www.scholarships.gov.in** (a link to the site is also available at [www.minorityaffairs.gov.in](http://www.minorityaffairs.gov.in)) or Mobile App-National Scholarships (NSP).

Detailed 'Instructions' for filling online application and "Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)" are available on the National Scholarship Portal homepage.

Applicants are advised to give only that bank account details which remains in active mode or compliant as per bank's instructions so that payment of Scholarship does not fail.

#### **For Schools/ Institutes:**

Eligible Schools/Institutes where minority student is studying, should get themselves registered with Aadhaar (if not done earlier) on National Scholarship Portal at "Services" option and submit the printout copy of Institute (KYC) Registration Forms along with supporting documents to the concerned District Nodal Officer for approval. Institutions whose KYC forms are already approved are requested to authenticate AADHAAR details for Institute Nodal Officers (INOs) and Head of Institutes at Institute Login on NSP for applications verification. **"Applications Verification" option will not be activated at Institute Login on NSP if INOs failed to authenticate AADHAAR.** It is mentioned here that the institutional Head/ Institute Nodal Officer will keep the Online applications (Hard copy) along with supporting documents from the students. After receiving Online applications from the students, they will Login to the Institute and thoroughly verify/approve the Online applications within 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2021 and submit the verified list with seal and Signature along with supporting documents to the concerned District Nodal Officer on or before 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2022 for District level verification.
